1.	Participate in Job Fair	On April 14, 2011, the stations participated in an on-campus recruiting job fair at Southeastern Louisiana University. Station participants included our Human Resource Manager and our Southeastern intern.

We hosted an intern in the Sales and Promotion department in Summer and Fall 2011. Supervised by our Promotions and Sales Managers, the intern's duties included setting up events, remotes, generating reports and spreadsheets for station management, creating sales packages, and setting up proposals from different vendors.
3.	Internship Program	Guaranty Broadcasting Company of Baton Rouge, LLC conducts an internship program in association with Louisiana State University in Baton Rouge in an effort to expose students to all aspects of the radio industry. We hosted four interns from LSU in the Sales and Promotion department in Spring, Summer and Fall 2011. Supervised by our Promotions and Sales Managers, the intern's duties included setting up events, remotes, generating reports and spreadsheets for station management, creating sales packages, and setting up proposals from different vendors.
4	Participate in Scholarship Program	Guaranty Broadcasting Company of Baton Rouge, LLC sponsors a scholarship program with the mass communications program at Southern University. We work with the program director to solicit scholarship applicants, establish the criteria for the program and judge the applicants. We award a grant of \$1,000 to a Southern University student on annual basis. To be chosen for the scholarship program, the student must be majoring in mass communications, have a 3.0 grade point average, and demonstrate need. The recipient for this reporting period will receive the award during a presentation scheduled for Spring 2012.
